ADMINISTRATOR'S NOTES TO BRAILLE EDITION

Braille-reading students may need more time to take the test than will print readers. The teacher or administrator of the test will instruct the student how to take the test. The method in which the student is to answer the test questions and the use of any answer sheets or separate documents should be explained before test administration. The student may need extra paper to answer open-ended questions.

These test administrator's notes include instructions given to the student, indicating what the student will encounter in the braille edition. Directional words, such as "below," may have been changed to reflect placement in the braille booklet. Running instructions like "GO ON" have been omitted, but instructions such as "WAIT" and "STOP" have been retained. Unless otherwise noted, in the braille versions, decorative graphics, pictures and accompanying captions, and boxes around text have been omitted.

Print and braille page numbers are listed in the following chart. The braille transcription may have required blank pages where noted. Other changes or omissions are also listed in the chart.
